Tee Times

Tee times are handled completely by e-mail. If you wish to sign up for play, or cancel, please e-mail Susan Browning at papagowga@cox.net by Wednesday at 11AM. Pairings will be done by the secretary and president, and will be sent by e-mail before noon on Thursday. Pairing requests will be honored wherever possible, but first consideration is for pace of play.

Tournament pairings will be done by tournament chairpersons by gross or net scores depending on format.

Cancellations or requests to be added to the tee sheet after Thursday at noon should be coordinated through the pro shop. Please call 602.275.8428.

Papago Cancellation Policy

Cancellation of a tee time must be made no later than 12 Noon on the Wednesday before play. Members who sign up for tee times and do not adhere to the cancellation policy will be subject to a \$15.00 late cancellation penalty fee. There are no exceptions to this policy.

There will be no cancellation of play for any reason (including inclement weather) unless the course is closed by the Golf Course Superintendent. You need to call the course on the day of play to determine if the Course Superintendent has closed the golf course.

Tournament Schedule

All events are flighted unless otherwise specified. Play of the Day prize money will be paid provided there are three members competing. There must also be at least one other member present for the duration of the round to be eligible for a POD prize. For State Medallion Rounds, players are required to turn in a separate scorecard with gross and net scores. Please note that you must sign up for major tournaments eight days in advance (or on the Friday before the tournament).

January (continued)

- 20 Aces Wild – Subtract all one putts from final score – full handicap – State Medallion Round 3
- 27 Stableford – Strokes as they fall
Bogey +1, Par +2, Birdie +3, Eagle +4
Last day to sign up for President's Cup
State Medallion Round 4

February

- 3 President's Cup Round 1
- 10 President's Cup Round 2
- 17 David & Goliath – 5 longest & 4 shortest holes - 1/2 Hcp
- 24 Middle Holes – 6 through 14 only – 1/2 Handicap

March

- 2 Two Person Best Ball – Pick your own Partner
- 9 & 10 Phoenix City Championship at Aguila – No Play of the Day
- 16 Jinx Day – Three worst holes revert to par. Full Handicap.
- 23 Quota - Subtract your handicap from 36. This becomes the "quota" that you must meet. You get 8 points for an eagle, 4 points for a birdie, 2 points for a par, 1 point for a bogie. These are based on gross scores on each hole. The goal is to get more points than your quota. The person with the MOST points OVER their quota wins.
Example; You are a 16 handicap. 36 minus 16 is 20. 20 is your quota. If you get 6 pars times 2 and 9 bogies times 1, you have 12 + 9 = 21 points. You beat your quota by +1.

The Eclectic Tournament allows you to better your score on each hole for three consecutive rounds. Your best score on each hole out of the 3 rounds is your eclectic score. You need not play in all three rounds to compete.

This is a two person net Best Ball competition. Choose your own partner. Your combined best ball score for both rounds will be totalled.

This is a net tournament. You must play in both rounds in order to be eligible for prizes.

Last day to sign up: January 27

This is a flighted gross and net competition. You must play in both rounds to be eligible.
